- Pesticides
- Poisons (weed killers, etc.)
- Household Batteries
- Car Batteries
- Paints/Paint Thinner
- Aerosols
- Loaded Guns
- Fertilizer
- Liquid Bleach
- Charcoal
- Chemicals (i.e., dark room chemicals)
